Fairshare accounts should all be showing \$225. Please make sure you log in and check your balances because we are currently showing behind \$20,000 in fairshare fees. This can affect the indoor percussion/winterguard, band banquet, and spring activities. There are 3 ways to get a discount on your fairshare---1-you can send in your free/reduced forms by Nov 1st. 2-if you work 3 separate games with 3 different shifts you can receive \$50 off 3-multiple kids in band. The concession stand credits will not be credited until after Thanksgiving.

Fundraiser – We are going to be selling Pasta! We will sell it Oct 1st – Oct 25th. You can complete order form or order online for out of town guests. When you send in your payments on Oct 25th, we only need 1 check per band student.

Competition- We are traveling to Louisville, KY on the weekend of 9/20-9/22. If you are chaperoning this trip you will need to attend a meeting on 9/17 at 6pm. There is an email going

out so you will know who your child's chaperone is. We are planning to leave at 8am Friday morning and due to come back around 10pm Sunday night. Kids will be responsible for meals on Friday and Sunday. Friday night we will be going to Dave and Busters and the cost is \$27. This includes a \$20 game card and dinner. Saturday meals are covered.

October 5th – Is the Groovin in the Grove in Hattiesburg, MS at Oak Grove High School. We will be spending the entire day down there. Boosters will cover 1 meal and the kids will need to bring their own lunch that day. More details will come.

October 12th – Pearl Competition – 2 shows that day; morning evaluation and night competition.
